

## Wisconsin

Voters in Wisconsin will elect a Governor and Lt. Governor, Attorney General, and state legislators in the 2018 election cycle. All 99 seats are up in the House and 17 seats are up in the Senate. Republicans will be defending a trifecta while Democrats hope to pick up a Governor's Mansion and gain ground in the legislature.

Tony Evers has served as State Superintendent for ten years, prior to which he was an educator.

Evers has hit Governor Walker on the Foxconn deal claiming that jobs could go to out of state contractors and that it will take the state 25 years to break even on the tax credits.

Evers supports Medicaid expansion. He supports allowing Wisconsinites to refinance their student loans at a lower interest rate.

He wants to invest more in infrastructure including repairing roads and expanding broadband to every home and business.

He wants to initiate criminal justice reform including ban the box legislation, investments in drug courts, and eliminating mandatory minimums. He also supports legalizing marijuana.

Evers is in favor of [eliminating](#) the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation.

He has pledged to reverse the cuts the current Administration made to Planned Parenthood.

Evers supports a \$15 minimum wage.

Evers has tried to tie Governor Walker to President Trump, even [releasing](#) an ad featuring the two executives in multiple photos with the words "It's time to take our country and our state back from Donald Trump and Scott Walker." He's also come out with a negative ad, essentially calling Governor Walker out for running for higher office.
