

## Maryland

Voters in Maryland will elect a Governor and Lt. Governor, Attorney General, and state legislators in the 2018 election cycle. All 141 seats in the State House are up as well as all 47 seats in the State Senate. The state house is a Democratic stronghold while Republicans are expected to retain the Governors Mansion.

Attorney General Brian Frosh served in the Maryland House of Delegates and State Senate before being elected to the office in 2014.

Attorney General Frosh's campaign is running on his record of suing the Trump Administration and corporations, touting his recovery of hundreds of millions of dollars for constituents from predatory lenders, Wall Street banks, tobacco companies and polluters. He specifically cites \$10 million from EpiPen maker Mylan in a Medicaid fraud settlement.

He has sued the Trump Administration for undermining the ACA, violating civil rights, failing to protect students from predatory, for-profit schools, undermining protections for clean air, clean water and for violating the Emoluments Clauses of the Constitution.

He is running on crime prevention and consumer protection citing that his office has gone after sham charities and businesses. He has joined suits against for-profit colleges. He is also running on environmental protection policies and opposes any drilling in the Bay.
