Voters in New Mexico will elect a Governor and Lt. Governor, Attorney General, and state legislators in the 2018 election cycle. All 70 seats are up in the House where Democrats will be defending a majority. New Mexico is considered a gubernatorial battleground state.

Michael Hendricks is running as a political outsider with the campaign message – reminiscent of 2016’s major theme of “draining the swamp” – of returning power to the people.

His campaign’s focus thus far has been on reducing crime by creating local crime fighting coalitions and making the office more transparent.

If elected Attorney General, he has stated that he will focus on anti-corruption, anti-crime, and pro-business measures.
