



## Alabama

Voters in Alabama will elect a Governor and Lt. Governor, Attorney General, and state legislators in the 2018 election cycle. All 105 seats in the State House are up as well as all 35 seats in the State Senate. Republicans currently dominate state politics – Alabama is a deep red Republican trifecta and should remain so after November.

Attorney General Steve Marshall was appointed to the position in 2017. He holds traditional conservative values: he is pro-life, pro-second amendment rights, anti-regulation, and pro-states' rights.

Attorney General Marshall joined eight other states in opposing the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals policy in court and is a vocal supporter of the Trump Administration's immigration policies.

He is the co-chair of the [Alabama Opioid Overdose & Addiction Council](#) and is an advocate for improving and investing more money in the state's Prescription Drug Monitoring Program. He is also supportive of additional funding for treatment services and recovery support.

He supports additional training for front line police officers and has launched an initiative to lower the state's crime level. He is in favor of limiting capital murderers in their ability to file appeals.
