



## North Dakota

Voters in North Dakota will elect an Attorney General and state legislators in the 2018 cycle. Forty-eight (48) of the 94 seats are up in the state House as well as 24 of 47 state Senate seats. Republicans are expected to maintain control of the legislature and the Office of Attorney General.

Attorney General Wayne Stenehjem was first elected to the office in 2000. He is running on his record of accomplishments and pledges to keep North Dakota safe and to uphold the Constitution.

His office has recently [joined](#) a coalition of Attorneys General calling on the Federal Communications Commission to create new rules to allow telephone service providers to block more illegal robocalls. His office has also filed suit against opioid manufacturers.

Attorney General Stenehjem [opposed](#) the Waters of the US rule and supported the U.S. EPA's withdrawal. He also [called](#) the *Wayfair* decision a victory for the state's brick and mortar retail stores.

Attorney General Stenehjem has made drug enforcement a top priority of his administration. He also touts his work in curbing domestic violence in the state.
