



## New Hampshire

Voters in New Hampshire will elect a Governor, Lt. Governor and state legislators in the 2018 election cycle. All 400 seats are up in the state House and all 24 seats are up in the state Senate. Republicans will be defending the governorship and both chambers.

### Governor

#### Republican Nominee

#### [Governor Chris Sununu](#)

Governor Chris Sununu was first elected in 2016. He is running on his record as governor including highlighting bipartisan proposals he has supported like the state's Medicaid expansion.

Governor Sununu is running for re-election at a time when New Hampshire boasts one of the lowest unemployment rates in the nation and has the fastest growing economy in the region. He is touting the elimination of over 1,600 regulations and the lowering of the Business Profits and Enterprises Taxes.

Governor Sununu is touting his administration's work on establishing full-day kindergarten and investing \$5 million in higher education scholarships. He strongly supports school choice and actively engaged the legislature this session to pass a bill that established Education Freedom Savings Accounts.

He created the state's only youth drug treatment center and has added 60 new beds for community mental health. Governor Sununu also opposes legalization of marijuana.
