

Vermont

Voters in Vermont will elect a Governor, Lt. Governor, Attorney General and state legislators in the 2018 election cycle. All 150 seats are up in the state House and all 30 seats are up in the state Senate. Split government control is expected to continue after the general.

Janssen Willhoit

State Representative Janssen Willhoit was nominated by the Republican state committee to take on sitting Attorney General T.J. Donovan.

State Representative Willhoit served five years in a Kentucky prison for theft by deception. He was eventually pardoned by Governor Beshear.

He wants to <u>implement</u> juvenile and criminal justice reform including more rehabilitation programs. He also pledges a more transparent and accountable government.

While serving on the House Judiciary Committee, Representative Willhoit <u>favored</u> a rax-and-regulate model for legalizing marijuana.
