Voters in South Carolina will elect a Governor, Lt. Governor, Attorney General, and state legislators in the 2018 election cycle. All 124 seats are up in the House. Republicans have a trifecta the Palmetto State and should continue their dominance after the November elections.

Attorney General Alan Wilson has held the office since 2010. His tenure has been intertwined with the Obama Administration – his office filed suit many times and his first ad for re-election cites that while President Obama is no longer in office, Wilson is still fighting federal overreach.

He joined in the lawsuit against the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals policy and opposes sanctuary localities.

He is pro-life. He is pro-second amendment rights and supports reciprocity for concealed carry.

South Carolina joined the lawsuit against opiate manufacturers and the multistate antitrust investigation of the generic drug industry in 2017.

Trivia: When elected in 2010, Wilson was the youngest person to ever become a state Attorney General.
