Voters in Maryland will elect a Governor and Lt. Governor, Attorney General, and state legislators in the 2018 election cycle. All 141 seats in the State House are up as well as all 47 seats in the State Senate. The state house is a Democratic stronghold while Republicans are expected to retain the Governors Mansion.

Craig Wolf

Craig Wolf has served as Assistant State's Attorney and senior Circuit Court prosecutor in Allegany County, Maryland. He is also currently serving in the 354th Civil Affairs Brigade.

His campaign slogan is "Creating a safer Maryland together." Wolf wants to tackle human trafficking and the violent crime rate in Baltimore.

Wolf has been critical of current Attorney General Brian Frosh (D) <u>stating</u> in an interview that he "has essentially made himself a legislator, executive and judiciary all in one, and he is unaccountable. Frosh decided a few years ago he can sue the (Trump) administration willy-nilly, at will."

Wolf is focusing on public safety and is in favor of stronger punishment for violent drug dealers as well as mandatory minimums. Though, for non-violent drug offenders, particularly opioid addicts, Wolf is in favor of rehab programs in lieu of jail time.

Trivia: Wolf joined the Army at age 40 after the September 11 attacks.
