

## INDIANA

Voters in Indiana will elect a Governor, Lt. Governor, and Attorney General this cycle. All 100 House seats will be on the ballot as well as half (25) of the Senate. Republicans are expected to maintain control the Governor's Office, Lt. Governor's Office, Office of the Attorney General, and the Legislature.

### Governor

#### [Donald Rainwater \(Libertarian\)](#)

Donald Rainwater is running on the Libertarian ticket for Indiana's governorship. He is a Navy veteran. Rainwater holds traditional Libertarian ideals and wants to eliminate much of the current state government bureaucracy.

Rainwater is vehemently opposed to the current statewide facemask mandate issued by Governor Holcomb (R). He disagreed with the Governor's decisions that closed businesses and implemented social distancing. If elected, he would not mandate vaccinations.

Rainwater pledges to oppose any efforts to increase taxes in the state. He supports abolishing the state's personal income tax as well as the state's residential property tax.

He supports decriminalization and legalization of marijuana as well as expunging the records of those who have been convicted of a marijuana-related, non-violent drug offense.

Rainwater supports charter schools. He would reduce the size and scope of the State Department of Education with goals of returning the decision-making power to the local School Boards and School District administrators. He favors incorporating vocational courses into high school instead of making any investments in post-secondary programs.

Rainwater has also pledged to work with the General Assembly to pass Constitutional Carry legislation.

As of [July 15](#), Rainwater had raised a total just north of \$10,000. He will [debate](#) his two opponents on October 20 and October 27.
